4. COMPETITION METHOD

1st STEP – GROUP PHASE: 2 groups, x 4 teams, round robin system in each group.

2nd STEP – FINAL PHASE:

4th team of group A plays against 4th team of group B to determine places 7 & 8.

3rd team of group A plays against 3rd team of group B to determine places 5 & 6.

2nd team of group A plays against 2nd team of group B to determine places 3 & 4.

1st team of group A plays against 1st team of group B to determine places 1 & 2.

POINT ALLOCATIONS:

EEVZA competition standing is based on the number of matches won.

There is a tie between Participants when each Participant has the same number of matches won. In case of a tie, the standing of the Participants is established by using the following criteria in the following mentioned order, until the tie ends:

a. In descending order by the number of allocated points for won and lost matches, Points for won and lost matches are allocated as follow:

Winner 3:0 or 3:1 3 points
Winner 3:2 2 points
Looser 2:3 1 point
Looser 1:3 or 0:3 0 points

- b. In descending order by the set quotient resulting from the division of all sets won by all sets lost during the EEVZA competition,
- c. In descending order by the set points quotient resulting from the division of all set points scored by all sets points lost during the EEVZA competition,
- d. In descending order by the result(s) of the match(es) played between them.

9. MEDICAL SERVICES & CONTROL

All players are obliged to present a EEVZA Health Certificate http://eevza.eu/wpic/eevza-v-m4-2016.pdf. Each Team Official Representative, participating in the competition, must present during the Preliminary Inquiry.

The organizer will provide first aid. All other medical services should be paid in accordance with the Rules of Polish medical service.

Any Application for the therapeutic use exemption must be sent confidentially to the Organizer no less 30 days before the concerned match.







10. OFFICIAL VOLLEYBALL RULES & BALLS

EEVZA Championships shall be organized and played under the Official Rules of The Game laid down by the FIVB; shall only take place in halls, confirmed by concerned National Federation and approved by Technical Delegate or Jury. The only Ball to be used for all matches is MIKASA MVA-200.

11. UNIFORMS

Jerseys and shorts must comply with FIVB Officials Rules. Publicity on uniforms must comply with the CEV Regulations concerning advertising material on the Uniforms of National teams, which are available on the CEV website.

For the EEVZA AGE Championships each team must have available 2 sets of uniforms, each one in different color. Player's family name or nickname is recommended, but not mandatory.

12. EXPENSES

EXPENSES COVERED BY THE ORGANIZER

- All transportation expenses from the international airport to the hotel and competition site and back
- Board and lodging for max 21 persons (12-14 players, 6 officials + 1 referee) per team, for a total max of 8 double rooms and 5 single rooms per team. Referees can be accommodated in dbl rooms.

EXPENSES COVERED BY THE PARTICIPATING DELEGATIONS

- Each team shall bear its own international traveling expenses to the international airport of arrival/departure.
- A maximum of 3 (three) extra persons, in addition to the 20 official team members may accompany their respective delegations at their own expense (the names have to be communicated to the organizers, using the EEVZA-05 form). The *extra* persons are entitled to single rooms for the price of **100 EUR** (the price includes all services provided to the official team members).
- Each team must pay a contribution fee to the organizer for each of the official member of its delegation. The fee is 50, EURO per day per person except referee. Arrival and departure day counting as together 1 day. This amount must be paid through bank transfer to the following bank account till the arrival to the competition and must be settled even if the duration of the stay is shorter:

For no presence of the Referee in a delegation, concerned National Federation will be sanctioned with the fine 500 EUR, which has to be paid by concerned National Federation to the Organizer.

POCKET MONEY

Only for those EEVZA competitions, which are considered as Official Qualification Round of concerned European AGE Competition, pocket money for the nominated EEVZA Neutral Technical delegate and Referee Delegate is adopted 75 EUR per all staying period and is mentioned as EEVZA Support to Organizer. Organizing Federation is responsible for paying all taxes according to the National Law of concerned country.

13. PRELIMINARY INQUIRY

Preliminary Inquiry will be carried out by the Technical Delegate on the 12th December 2018 according to the time of the teams' arrival. Venue of Preliminary Inquiry tbd in Handbook.

2 (two) sets of player's uniform (captain's & libero's)

If Medical Doctor or Physiotherapist haven't CEV Accreditation he/she needs relevant confirmation letter by concerned National Federation.
